

## Zero Tolerance (ZT) Issues in the Supply Chain

Category	Issue	Priority
Transparency	<ul><li>Repeated denied visits</li><li>Workers fleeing</li></ul>	ZT
Employment is freely chosen	Forced, bonded, indentured, and/or prison labour	ZT
General Health and Safety	No sandblasting processes are used in the production unit	ZT
Building Safety	<ul> <li>Missing or expired building license/fire license and no application or third party inspection available</li> <li>Structure and use of the production building not aligned with the approved building plan (high risk for workers)</li> <li>Multi-tenancy not meeting four criteria</li> </ul>	ZT
Emergency/Fire Preparedness	Industrial generators and boilers not isolated from production areas	ZT
Production Unit- sponsored dormitories/living area	Dormitories/living area not clearly separated from the production facility and/or warehouse (high risk for workers)	ZT
Child labour shall not be used	<ul> <li>Worst forms of child labour</li> <li>No workers below the age of 16 years are hired</li> </ul>	ZT
Wage and benefit compliance	Minimum wages not paid (>50% of sampled workers)	ZT
	<ul> <li>Overtime premiums not paid (gap &gt; 50% and number of sampled workers &gt; 50%)</li> </ul>	ZT
	Wages are paid delayed (current workers > 30 days delay + more than once in past 12 months)	ZT
Regular employment is provided	<ul> <li>No valid work permits for foreign/imported workers available</li> <li>Probationary wages not meeting C&amp;A requirements (&gt;50% sampled workers)</li> </ul>	ZT
No harsh or inhumane treatment is allowed	Cases of physical / sexual / verbal / mental abuse observed	ZT
Wastewater	<ul> <li>No legally required offsite or onsite effluent treatment plant (ETP) available</li> <li>Wastewater discharge not meeting the legal requirements</li> </ul>	ZT
Compliance with the law	No valid business license and no application available	ZT
Subcontracting	Unauthorized subcontracting and homeworking	ZT
